

GETTING TO KNOW ZOOM IN THE SCOTTISH JEWISH COMMUNITY

SCoJeC Projects and Outreach Manager Fiona Frank will be running two half hour 'practice' Zoom meetings for members of the Scottish Jewish Community. These will take place at:

5pm on Tuesdays 2, 9, 16, 23, and 30 June

Before signing up, you may find it useful to watch this [2 minute video](#) about signing up for a Zoom meeting.

Signing up for the practice sessions

The session will take place on Zoom, an online platform that is being used a lot for 'virtual meetings' during the current crisis. There are several ways for you to access the sessions:

1. Click on this link www.scojec.org/zoom-practice.html or copy and paste it into the address bar of your browser. Zoom will download automatically. Click on "Open Zoom.US application" and then "Join with Computer Audio" if you're given an option to do so.

Please note that **you will need a password** – please contact Fiona@scojec.org to ask for this.

2. Download and install Zoom on your computer (it's free) at <https://zoom.us>, or download it from the App or Play store on your phone. It may take a few minutes to download and install, so don't leave it until just before the first meeting. After downloading, you will be able to open the application and enter the meeting ID, which is **541 218 167**.

Please note that **you will need a password**. If so – please contact Fiona@scojec.org to ask for this.

3. You can phone into the meeting from any phone (although this way you won't be able to see other participants. Dial **0131 460 1196** and enter the meeting ID which is **541 218 167**. (If calling from outwith the UK, you can find your local dial-in number [here](#).) Please note calls will be subject to your normal phone rates.

Please note that **you will need a password** – please contact Fiona@scojec.org to ask for this.

You can try accessing the meeting space at any time to check that your set-up works – please don't wait till just before the meeting if you haven't used Zoom before.
